On Saturday, March 27th, Habitat for Humanity of Burlington County, NJ will dedicate the home at 135 Old Marlton Pike in Medford to a deserving partner family of five.

For the past 23 years, the Habitat for Humanity affiliate of the international nonprofit organization has helped place 75 children and their families in decent, affordable homes in the Burlington County area. This Saturday will mark the 36th completed Habitat home in the local community.



The mission of Habitat for Humanity is to eliminate poverty housing and make decent shelter a matter of conscience and action. To do so, Habitat staff and volunteers build and rehabilitate substandard houses and create an affordable housing program for low to moderate income families. With a zero percent interest mortgage rate, homeownership becomes an attainable reality for Habitat partner families. "Working closely with the partner family helps me to see that our organization is truly making a difference," said Office Manager Carle Banks. "From the initial family selection meeting to the signing of the partner agreement, I enjoy walking them through this process."

In addition to the dedication ceremony at noon on Saturday, Habitat and the new homeowners, along with their three children, will be sharing an Open House with the community of supporters and volunteers from 9am-11am and 2pm-4pm.
